Conditions of Play for the Invercargill Licensing Trust Southland Secondary & Intermediate Schools Indoor Bowls Pairs Tournaments

These Tournaments are for Secondary and Intermediate students who have gained a proficiency in this sport through school or outside participation.

Separate Tournaments are to be run simultaneously for Intermediate Students (years 7 & 8) and for Secondary Students (years 9-13)

Tournaments to be held Thursday, 29th July 2010 at the Indoor Bowls Centre, 50 Onslow Street, Invercargill. Tournaments to commence at 9.30 am and expected to conclude by 2.00 pm.

Tournaments are to consist of five rounds of pairs games. Three rounds before lunch, each game to be of 9 ends or 35 minutes duration, and two rounds after lunch, each game to be of 8 ends or 30 minutes duration.

Points to be awarded: 2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw. If no clear winner found, count back to be made of ends won &/or actual game points scored.

Prizes and certificates will be awarded to the winning teams in both sections.

School Trophy to be presented to the winning school, in each section, to be decided on points scored, for wins and draws, divided by the number of teams entered in the competition.

Note: *A minimum of two teams must be entered in the same section by any school to qualify for the School Trophy.*

Footwear: Flat soled shoes, clean sports shoes or alternately socks to be worn. Play in 'street shoes', jandals or bare feet not permitted.
