| April – July 2010

- 20 April** **Horseshoe Bend** **Lois**
 A trip into Central Otago to see the beautiful autumn colours. Cross the Clutha River on the historic Horseshoe Bend Bridge and on to the ‘Lonely Graves’.
 Cost: \$12
- 18 May** **Winton** **June**
 Heritage Trail. Winton first came to prominence in the days of the gold rushes and has some interesting historic sites.
 Cost: \$10
- 15 June** **Waituna Lagoon & Awarua Bay** **Isobel & Anne**
 Waituna lagoon is occasionally open to the sea and its brackish waters are an important habitat for wildfowl, native fish and trout. The surrounding wetlands have unusual plants. Awarua Bay is home to a large number of bird species so bring your binoculars. Heaps of shells to collect in the bay.
 Cost: \$12
- 20 July** **Mystery Trip**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- NAMETAGS will be available once you have paid your annual registration fee. They will be available on the bus or at Sport Southland; these will not be posted out.
- Every walk will meet outside the Gore District Council, where there is lots of parking. Please arrive at 9.20am, as the buses will leave at 9.30am sharp unless otherwise stated. ETR (estimated time of return) about 4pm unless stated.
- Leave the 4 seats behind the bus driver free for the leaders so they can advise the driver on travel routes.
- The road code applies to all road walks – NO MORE THAN 2 ABREAST AND FACING ONCOMING TRAFFIC, THIS IS NOT NEGOTIABLE. PLEASE KEEP AS FAR OFF THE ROAD AS PRACTICABLE. BE SEEN!
- All walkers please stay behind the leaders as they have planned the walk and know of any detours, etc.
- If walking on private farm land, please stay close to the fence line.
- Buses will follow where possible so you can get back on if necessary.
- Bring a campstool, thermos (or drink bottles in the hot weather), food, comfortable shoes, water proof jacket and warm clothing, these can all be left on the buses while walking.
- Remember to bring the correct change for your bus fare. Bus fares are between \$5 - \$15.
- Please also have spare change available in case a donation is required for walks.
- Please show respect to everyone. Be considerate of others and private property please.
- If weather is in doubt on the day, please listen to Hokonui Gold radio station for cancellations.
